A brief report on program

On 11 July 2025, a programme named “Skill Development Workshop on Cleaning Products” was conducted at Deva Matha College Kuravilangad under the initiative of the Entrepreneurship Development Club. The programme was handled by Mr. Saju Joseph Vadakkal, Managing Officer of the Pala Social Welfare Society. The class was conducted for the 1st year and 2nd year students of M.Com and M.Sc Mathematics.

The class started at 9:30 am with a small prayer and the self-introduction of Mr. Saju Joseph Vadakkal. His words greatly impressed the students, and everyone attended the class with great interest. The class mainly discussed the preparation of daily-use cleaning products.

The first part of the session started at 9:30 am. In this session, he explained how to prepare washing powder for clothes and bathing soap (Pears), the ingredients required, and the steps to be followed. The active participation of students in preparing the products was another important attraction of this programme. The class continued till 11:10 am, and after that, there was a 20-minute break.

The second part of the session started at 11:30 am. In this session, Saju sir discussed how to prepare UJALA (Blue), the ingredients required, and the steps to be followed. The active participation of students in preparing the products greatly influenced them and helped them learn more clearly and deeply. This session continued till 12:30 pm, after which the students went to their classrooms for lunch break.

The third part of the session started at 1:15 pm. In this session, Saju sir discussed how to prepare liquid handwash and floor cleaners using natural and non-harmful ingredients, and explained the steps to be followed. This session lasted till 3:15 pm.

The class was both attractive and informative. The students enjoyed the class very much. This class opened a new opportunity for the students in entrepreneurship through both theory and practical experience. The products prepared during the programme were decided to be taken for exhibition and sale on the occasion of World Youth Skills Day celebration held at Deva Matha College Kuravilangad on 15 July 2025.
