All staff rooms and most of the classrooms have LAN ports through internal networking which ensures best-in-class network speed without interruptions. The traditional attendance marking system of students was replaced with the technologically advanced system called Linways. The well equipped and fully automated library follows the Open Access System where students and teachers have access to digital resources, previous question papers, e-books, and e-journals through INFLIBNET- NLIST. Using the latest version of KOHA software, the institution has made the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) available to enable author-based, subject-based, title-based, and publisher-based search facilities.Every department has at least one classroom furnished with LCD projector and at least one computer having internet connectivity and a printer. The institution has a well developed computer lab with 113 computers.
