

On 5th March 2024, the NSS (National Service Scheme) unit of Deva Matha College, Kuravilangad organized a medical camp aimed at providing health check-ups and issuing health cards to all the first-year undergraduate students.

The medical cam was organized in collaboration with local healthcare professionals and organizations. The primary objective of the camp was to ensure the health and well-being of the first-year undergraduate students by conducting comprehensive health screenings and providing necessary medical assistance. The camp involved the following

1 Health Check-ups: Various health parameters including height, weight, blood pressure, vision, and basic medical history were recorded for each student. Qualified medical professionals conducted thorough physical examinations to identify any underlying health issues.

2. Medical Consultation: Students had the opportunity to consult with doctors regarding any health concerns or queries they had. The doctors provided personalized medical advice and recommendations based on the individual health status of each student.



Green Village Initiatives

Haritha Mithram Smart Garbage Monitoring System Implementation

The Haritha Mithram Smart Garbage Monitoring program represents a technology-driven Green Village Initiative of the Kerala Government. This was implemented in Kuravilangad Gramapanchayath by NSS volunteers of Deva Matha College to enhance waste management practices at the household level. NSS volunteers conducted two-month long comprehensive door-to-door visits throughout the community, systematically installing QR codes at residential properties. These QR codes serve as digital monitoring tools, enabling efficient tracking and management of household waste generation and disposal patterns. The program was executed in close partnership with the Harithakarma Sena (Green Action Force), demonstrating effective coordination between student volunteers and local environmental workers. This collaboration ensured proper implementation protocols were followed and sustainable waste management practices were established.
